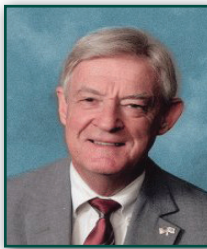
# Keynote Speakers



## **Ivica (Ivan) Ducic, MD, PhD, FAENS**

Dr. Ducic is a Professor of Plastic Surgery & Neurosurgery and the Director of Peripheral Nerve Surgery Institute at Georgetown University Hospital. He is Board Certified by the American Board of Plastic Surgery and Past-President of the American Society for Peripheral Nerve. Dr. Ducic expertise in peripheral nerve surgery has earned him an international reputation and is widely published including media coverage for his treatment of chronic pain, including migraine headaches. He serves as an Associate Editor of the Annals of Plastic Surgery for Nerve section and he has published over 80 original studies, many landmark studies on nerve surgery.



## **Forest Tennant, MD, MPH, DrPH, FAENS**

Forest Tennant, MD, DrPH, started his pain clinic in 1975 and served as a Medical Officer in the US Army and US Public Health Service, as well as consultant to the US Food and Drug Administration, National Institute on Drug Abuse, Drug Enforcement Administration, LA Dodgers, National Football League, and NASCAR. He has authored over 300 scientific articles and books, and currently serves as Editor Emeritus of Practical Pain Management, the nation's most widely circulated pain journal for physicians. He has authored a handbook for pain for patients called "The Intractable Pain Patient's Handbook for Survival".

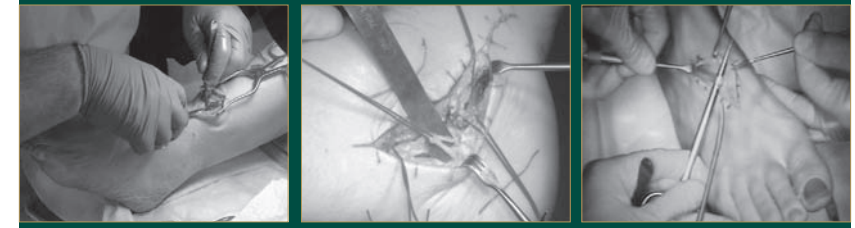
